This tour to China, departing in October 2016, is designed to be a little bit different. We will get off the tourist trail to visit the lesser seen side of China. We have called the tour the Wild China tour as we plan to visit areas of natural scenery, some of the rural areas of China as well as some very interesting gardens. The tour starts in the south of the country in old Canton province before time in the wild Yunnan province. We have included a Yang-tze River cruise, a trip to the famous Yellow Mountain, the Li River area and the beautiful water town of Wuzhen. We will once again use the experience of China Travel Service to show us the best of each area as we have done on previous tours. Meals, flights, boat cruises, all entries, tipping, visa fees, hotels and a private coach with an experienced English speaking guide in China are all included. Hotels and meals will be 4 star or higher.

#### Day 1 Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October Australia to Guangzhou (D)

Depart from either Brisbane, Sydney or Melbourne International airports for Guangzhou, China flying with China Southern CZ382 (0955/1655 – Brisbane flight). When we arrive we will transfer to our hotel. Dinner will be in the hotel tonight.

Hotel: Landmark Canton or similar 4 star hotel

#### Day 2 Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> October Guangzhou (BL)

Today we will venture into the Pearl city to visit the well renowned Southern China Botanical gardens and a lovely small garden call Qinghuiyuan (pictured right). As we tour the city we will see how it has rapidly transformed into a commercial & tourist hub.

# Day 3 Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> October Guangzhou to Lijiang (BLD)

Some free time this morning before we head to the airport to fly to Lijiang CZ3487 (1225/1655). This is where the wild part of the tour starts in the rural Yunnan province.

Hotel: Hexi Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

#### Day 4 Thursday 13th October Lijiang (BL)

Today we will have a very scenic day visiting the Jade Dragon Snow Mountain National park. We will take a chairlift to Yak meadow station and the on to the Baisha village to

see their famous frescos and other local highlights. Later you have the option of attending the Lijiang Impressions Show.

#### Day 5 Friday 14th October Lijiang to Dali (BLD)

First stop will be to the interesting Black Dragon Pool Park, and walk in the old town area before we drive through hills to arrive in Dali. Dali is famed as an ancient city that was a gateway to the Silk Road. It looks to be a fascinating old town.

Hotel: Landscape Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

#### Day 6 Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> October Dali to Kunming (BLD)

After breakfast we will visit the old town in Dali, the Bai Village and the wonderful Three Pagodas of the Chongsheng temple. After lunch we will drive the rural highway to Kunming. Farms, spectacular mountains & old villages will be some of the highlights of the journey.

Hotel : Jinjiang Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

#### Day 7 Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> October Kunming (BL)

The stone forest is one of the most amazing formation of limestone castes you will see anywhere. It covers an area of 400 square kilometers – we will visit one of the most scenic spots and allow some time for getting lost in the stone forest. We will also visit the flower market and the dragon gate in the Western Hills Park. This evening you have the option of seeing the Yunnan Impressions show

# Day 8 Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October Kunming to Guilin (BLD)

After checking out of the hotel we will visit the World Horticultural expo site. Unlike many such expo sites this one has been well maintained and has a great collection of gardens and colour. After lunch we will fly to Guilin.

# Day 9 Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> October Guilin (BL)

Today is a full day excursion to Longshan to see the famous rice paddies woven into the hillsides and the spectacular mountains and valleys of the area. Later visit the Zhuang and Yao minority hill tribe villages, then we will visit the Reed Flute cave. Return to Guilin for a free evening.

#### Day 10 Wednesday 19th October Guilin to Yangshou (BLD)

After breakfast we will cruise on the picturesque River Li towards Yangshou. Upon arrival we will have some free time in the famous local market. Tonight you may decide to see the optional Water Show Impressions. It is well worth seeing.

Hotel: New Century Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

## Day 11 Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October Yangshou to Chongqing (BLD)

This morning we will take the short flight to the amazing metropolis of Chongqing. We will have time to visit the zoo to see the Pandas among other animals. We will also have some sightseeing of the town hall and city square as time permits. In the afternoon we will board our Yangtze River cruise. We plan to cruise 5 star using the Victoria Cruise line (or similar).

#### Day 12 Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October Yangtze River Cruise (BLD)

Cruise the Yangtze. A range of stops and options for excursions will be available. Meals are a choice of Chinese or Western cuisine.

#### Day 13 Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> October Yangtze River Cruise (BLD)

Cruise the Yangtze. A range of stops and options for excursions will be available. Meals are a choice of Chinese or Western cuisine.

#### Day 14 Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> October Cruise to Yichang to Wuhan (BLD)

Cruise to the 3 Gorges dam for a close up look at this amazing engineering feet. Upon arrival in Yichang we will board our coach for our drive across the Yangtze delta to Wuhan.

Hotel: Best Western Mayflowers Hotel Wuhan or similar 4 star hotel

#### Day 15 Monday 24<sup>th</sup> October Wuhan (BL)

This morning our tour will include the Wuhan botanical gardens, the iconic Yellow crane tower and the new Wuhan Museum. We hope to time our visit to coincide with a musical performance that is said to be well worth seeing! We will have some free time in the afternoon and a free evening.

#### Day 16 Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> October Wuhan to Tunxi (BLD)

Depart Wuhan this morning for the Yellow Mountain area (see front cover). We will travel via coach to Tunxi city and visit the old Tunxi street area before checking into our hotel where we will have dinner tonight.

Hotel: Huangshan Xin'an Country Villa Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

#### Day 17 Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> October Yellow Mountain (B,D)

This morning we will leave our large luggage behind, taking only an overnight bag as we ascend the Yellow Mountain by Cable car. We will see the main features of this spectacular part of the world and you will have the option of going on a walking trail tour in the afternoon. Today lunch is at your own expense. Tonight we will stay on the mountain.

Hotel: Beihai Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

# Day 18 Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> October Yellow Mountain – Wuzhen (BLD)

We will have an early morning start to undertake a sunrise viewing tour – a must see when visiting the Yellow Mountain. Later in the morning we will descend to Tunxi and then board our coach to drive to Wuzhen. This is a beautiful small well preserved water town. Our hotel is a lovely place with a few nice surprises.... After we have checked in we will have a brief walking tour orientation of the town.

Hotel: Water Fair Inn Hotel or similar 4 star hotel

### Day 19 Friday 28<sup>th</sup> October Wuzhen (BD)

A longer walking tour will be available to explore this old village. The choice for transportation in Wuzhen is either walking or canal boat!. If you do want to ride the canal boat (at your own expense) that option is available and recommended. The rest of the day is free for exploration. Tonight our farewell dinner will be in the hotel restaurant.

#### Day 20 Saturday 29th October Wuzhen – Hangzhou to Australia (B and in flight)

Free time this morning to relax or explore. After check out we will travel via coach to Hangzhou airport to transfer to Guangzhou CZ3512 (1625/1825) and then fly home to Australia CZ381 (2110/0830+1 Brisbane flight)

# Day 21 Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> October – Arrive home (B in flight)

Arrive in Brisbane. (Or other ports as arranged)
